## 2025 REGISTRATION INFORMATION


Frequently Asked Questions	
What are the St. Marcellinus CSS feeder schools?	St. Gregory, St. Julia, St. Veronica, and St. Barbara.
When will feeder schools start the registration process?	The guidance department will reach out directly to feeder schools in early December to present to Grade 8s and distribute registration packages. Guidance will then pick up the completed registration packages January 2025.
What are the dates to register if I attended a non-feeder school and live in bounds?	Registration packages can be picked up in Student Services from January 13 <sup>th</sup> to January 24, 2024.
When can I drop off the completed registration package for non-feeder schools in bound students?	Completed registration packages must be returned to St. Marcellinus CSS on Tuesday January 28 <sup>th</sup> between 1:30 to 4 pm.
Do I need to be Catholic to register at St. Marcellinus CSS?	No, you do not need to be Catholic to register at St. Marcellinus, as we are an open access school. As we follow Catholic Curriculum expectations, the Catholic faith is embedded in everything that we do at St. Marcellinus.
Is this registration process for grade 10 to 12 as well?	No. The registration process for incoming grade 10 to 12 students will begin in Spring 2025.  Please complete the Google Form using the QR Code and staff will contact you for follow up.  
How do I know if I live in the boundaries?	Access <a href="http://www.stopr.ca">www.stopr.ca</a> under 'School Eligibility'.
Can I do anything to increase my odds of getting into St. Marcellinus CSS?	No.
What documentation will I need to provide for my package to be considered complete?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Proof of home address (2 pieces)</li> <li>• Proof of age of the child</li> <li>• Proof of Canadian citizenship</li> <li>• Updated immunization records (outside of DPCDSB)</li> <li>• Proof of English Separate School Support</li> </ul>

<b>Is there an activity fee?</b>	Yes, there is an optional activity fee of \$45.00 that can be paid once the registration process is complete. While the fee is optional, the fee supports a wide range of valuable programs and activities that enhance students' experience and helps create a vibrant school community.
<b>How do I know if my child was registered at St. Marcellinus CSS?</b>	You will receive a confirmation email in March 2025.
<b>What if I applied through the Online Registration portal?</b>	You will receive a confirmation email that will ask for additional supporting documentation.
<b>What if I don't live in the catchment area, but I want to attend. Do I apply now?</b>	<p>No, you do not apply. In this case, you would need to apply for a flexible boundary request through your home secondary Catholic school.</p> <p>Please complete the Google Form using the QR Code and staff will contact you for follow up in Spring 2025.</p> 
<b>Does St. Marcellinus offer Extended French or French Immersion?</b>	No. We offer a fantastic Core French program offered at all grade levels.
<b>What Specialist High Skills Major does St. Marcellinus offer?</b>	St. Marcellinus offers two SHSM programs: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hospitality and Tourism</li><li>• Arts and Culture</li></ul>
<b>What transition programs are offered to incoming grade 9 students?</b>	St. Marcellinus offers the Get Ready Program which provides incoming grade 9 students an opportunity to review literacy, numeracy, as well as effective learning strategies. The program runs in the last week of August. Information to register in this transition program will be made available in the Spring of 2025.
